At the meeting of the Joint Disability and Administrative Appeals Committees, held on December 22, 2021, the following members were present via live video teleconference: Keith Peercy, Chair, Betty Pendergrass, and Campbell Connell.

In addition, those present were Erin Surratt, KPPA, Liza Welch, KPPA, Ed Owens, KPPA, Victoria Hale, KPPA, Andrea Freadreacea, KPPA, Shaun Case, KPPA, Glenna Frasher, KPPA, and Tracy Chambers, Recording Secretary.

It was moved by Mr. Connell, seconded by Ms. Pendergrass, and carried to approve the Minutes of the October 25, 2021 Joint Disability and Administrative Appeals Committee Meeting.

Mr. Case and Ms. Frasher departed the meeting prior to entering closed session.

Mr. Peercy noted the necessity of closed session for the purpose of reviewing the disability applications and administrative appeals of Administrative Action Numbers: 20-T-07, and 20-D-38.

Following discussion in closed session, the Committee returned to open session, whereafter the following transpired.

It was moved by Ms. Pendergrass, seconded by Mr. Connell, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 20-T-07, to accept the Hearing Officer's Report, as modified in the Board Final Order, and to reinstate Claimant's disability retirement benefits, with a review in five years.

It was moved by Mr. Connell, seconded by Ms. Pendergrass, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 20-D-38, to remand this case in order for the Hearing Officer to issue a new Recommended Order regarding whether the Claimant is entitled to disability retirement benefits.
