

**MINUTES OF

The meeting of the Joint Disability and Administrative Appeals Committees, held on October 28, 2025, was called to order by Mr. Percy at 8:30 a.m. E.T. The following members were present via live video teleconference: Keith Percy, Chair, Dr. Crystal Miller, and Tommy McGraw.

In addition, those present from KPPA were Victoria Hale, JJ Alleman, Andrea Freadreacea, Jillian Hall, Liza Welch, Ed Owens, Phillip Cook, and Ashley McIntosh, KPPA Recording Secretary.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously to approve the Minutes of the August 14, 2025, Joint Disability and Administrative Appeals Committees Meeting.

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Mr. Percy noted the necessity of closed session for the purpose of reviewing the disability applications and administrative appeals of Administrative Action Numbers:

22-D-19, 22-D-34, 22-T-46, 22-T-50, 22-T-55, 22-T-95, 22-T-49, 21-PS-31, and 23-D-10.

It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously to enter closed session.

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Following discussion in closed session, the Committees returned to open session, whereafter the following transpired.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-D-19, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Approve Claimant's hazardous duty disability retirement benefits. Due to Claimant having reached normal retirement age a review period did not need to be set.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee

members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-D-34, to Remand to the Hearing Officer to correct issues as set forth in the Board Remand Order.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-T-46, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Continue Claimant's non-hazardous disability retirement benefits, as modified in the Board Final Order, with a review in two (2) years.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-T-50, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Continue Claimant's non-hazardous disability retirement benefits, as modified in the Board Final Order, with a review in five (5) years.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-T-55, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Continue Claimant's non-hazardous disability retirement benefits with a review in five (5) years.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-T-95, to Remand this case to the Hearing Officer to correct issues as set forth in the Board Remand Order.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 22-T-49, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Dismiss the appeal and Continue Claimant's non-hazardous disability retirement benefits with a review in three (3) years.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 21-PS-31, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Dismiss the appeal With Prejudice.

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It was moved by Dr. Miller, seconded by Mr. McGraw, and carried unanimously, that the Committee members having considered the Administrative Record, including the recommended order and any exceptions duly filed, in the case of Administrative Action Number: 23-D-10, to adopt the Hearing Officer's Recommendation to Dismiss the appeal.

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There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:57 a.m., E.T. to meet on December 22, 2025, at 9:30 A.M., E.T.
