OBJECTIVE: To serve the remaining term of the elected C.E.R.S. Trustee position on the Kentucky Retirement Board .

STRENGTHS: I was elected as Trustee for the County Employees Retirement System 2001-2005 term years, and was appointed to the following committees: Administrative and Disability Appeals, Legislative and Budget Committee, and was the Chairman of the Group Health Insurance over age 65 group. I was appointed to the Kentucky Group Health Insurance Board. I worked on the C.E.R.S. Reorganization sub-committee and on the Healthcare sub-committee of the Governor's Public Pension Reform Work Groups. While serving on the KRS Board, I completed the International Foundation of Employee Benefits Plans for parts I and II of the Certificate of Achievement in Public Plan Policy in Employee Health, and Employee Benefit Plans. I attended numerous financial seminars that were offered by NCPERS, and other organizations. For the past seven years, I have attended most of the Quarterly Board Meetings of KRS, many committee meetings, as well as the Board Retreats, and Educational Training Sessions. I am retired and have the time and the desire to devote to the duties of Trustee and would need very little training to do so.

I retired from the Jefferson County Police Department as Sergeant, after serving from April, 1965 until June, 1987. I served as Patrol Officer, Budget Officer, shift Commander for Patrol and Emergency Medical Services, and as Assistant Commander of the Hazardous Material Response Unit. I was employed as a Police Officer for the Louisville Division of Police from April 1963 until September 1964. I served in the United States Navy from June, 1954 until December, 1957.

EDUCATION: I attended Ahrens Trade High School 1953-1954, and left school to enlist in the United States Navy. I obtained my G.E.D. while on active duty. I attended both Indiana University and University of Louisville on the G.I. Bill. taking mostly core education classes and General Business Studies.

MEMBERSHIPS: I am a Board member of the Fraternal Order of Police, Local Lodge 614 and serve as the Pension/Healthcare Committee Chairman for the local and State Lodges, and as a committee member for the National Pension Committee. I am a Board member and current Secretary for the Jefferson County Federal Credit Union. I belong to the Kentucky Public Retirees, Jefferson Regional Chapter.
