Pension Reform Bill Introduced

Late yesterday, Senate Bill 1 was introduced. It's important to keep in mind that retirement benefits administered by KRS are based on state and federal law. This means the General Assembly has to introduce and pass legislation, to then be approved by the Governor, before any changes to benefits can occur. Please keep in mind that our staff can only explain benefit options as they are currently written in state law. We recommend our members check our website for legislative updates. [Read more](#)
