Retired State Government in August, 1999

1990-1999--Cabinet for Community Based Services, Division of Policy Development, formerly Cabinet for Human Resources, as an Internal Policy Analyst regarding Medicaid issues. Determined program implications for recipients and staff, analyzed current Federal and State laws and regulations to develop comprehensive implementation of the Medicaid Program, maintained policy manuals for staff of the Department for Social Insurance, clarified policy to lawmakers, the general public and recipients directly or through regional office staff.

1980-1990--Cabinet for Human Resources, Jefferson County office as a Casework Specialist Principal and determined eligibility for AFDC, Medical Assistance/Medicaid and Food Stamps. As case principal, I read cases behind fellow workers to determine accuracy of work and benefits given/terminated/denied. I was also responsible in place of supervisor, if needed.

1975-1980—Assigned from the Commissioner's Office as the Department's Liaison to the Human Services Coalition Alliance (HSCA) in Jefferson County, attempting to assist workers in all service agencies to be able to adequately refer clients to meet needs appropriate to their situation. HSCA came about after a young child in Jefferson County died of starvation around Thanksgiving and every agency in Jefferson County (State, City and County) had been in the home providing services, yet the child died. Laid off under the Brown Administration 5/80 as the only worker in the category of Graduate Social Worker III). I was re-employed 7/80.

1972-1975---I was assigned as a Graduate Social Worker III and made Supervisor for three months over the Intake Section in Jefferson County. I was asked to go to Frankfort to work with consultants advising on impact of services on clients of the agency out of the Commissioner's Office. Once that project ended, I was hired to work in the Office of Budget writing Food Stamp Policy and interpreting that policy to regional managers throughout the Commonwealth from 1973-1975. This also entailed meeting with Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) to determine appropriate policy implementation.

1970-1975---Attended Kent School of Social Work on the University of Louisville's campus where I was assigned field placement at the old General Hospital, making placements from the hospital to a home environment or facility and in my second year was assigned to the Federal Prison in Summit, Kentucky to do group therapy with inmates three times a week.

1968-1970---I was a Social Worker I assigned to the WIN (Work Incentive) Program to assist recipients of AFDC (Aid to Families with Dependent Children) in gaining needed education or job skills with the aim of getting off welfare.

1967-1968---I taught second grade at Christ the King School in Louisville as Sister Mary Helen Timperman and then, mid-year, as Miss Mary Helen Timperman. The final school day was June 3, 1968 and I started working for the Commonwealth on June 4, 1968. I could hardly wait!

1965-1968---I taught first grade at St. Francis School in Santa Fe, New Mexico. After hours, on weekends and during the summer I worked with delinquent boys and girls.

1960-1965---I joined the Sisters of Loretto to be of assistance to those in need. This involved five years of study, earning my BA in May, 1965 and being sent to teach first grade at Immaculate Conception school in Highland Park, Illinois. After five months I was switched to teach first grade in Santa Fe, New Mexico and the sister there replaced me in Illinois.

I am currently married to Emil Peter III, residing in Jefferson County. We have two boys, both grown and on their own. Emil Peter IV and his wife have two daughters in St. Louis, MO. and Eric Peter, currently living in Washington, D.C.
